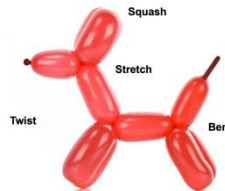
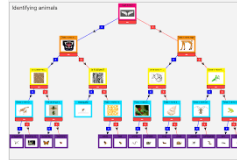

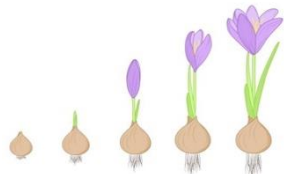

Why not watch the White Rose Maths videos to help you with your learning?

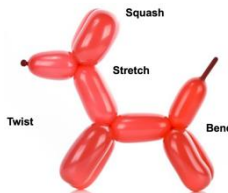
Science: Young Gardeners

Research facts about Hinduism and Sikhism. Visit a Gurdwara or a Mandir.



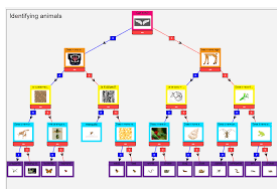
