It's been another thoughtful and meaningful week here in school, with lots of opportunities for the children to reflect, show kindness, and take part in special events together.

Monday's Assembly – Remembering

On Monday, we talked about remembering and the different things that help us to do so. The children shared what they already knew about Remembrance Day and why it is such an important occasion for so many people.

We explored the idea that good things can come out of difficult times and we looked closely at a photograph of Flanders Fields, discussing why people choose to buy and wear poppies as a sign of remembrance and hope for peace.

Remembrance Day

On Tuesday, the whole school came together in the playground for Remembrance Day. Some of our Year 6 pupils led the silence beautifully, sharing thoughtful poems and reflections. We also had the privilege of listening to Justin play the Last Post, creating a very moving and respectful atmosphere.

At 11am, on the 11th day of the 11th month, we all observed a two minutes' silence to honour and remember those who have served and sacrificed. The children showed exceptional respect and understanding throughout.

Pupil Parliament – Poppy Sale

Our Pupil Parliament have been busy selling poppies over the last two weeks. Many children purchased a poppy and wore it proudly during our two minutes' silence.

The Poppy Appeal is the Royal British Legion's biggest fundraising campaign and we are proud to be contributing to their work supporting the armed forces community.

A big thank you to all the children and adults who purchased a poppy - you truly helped to make a difference.

Anti-Bullying Week and Odd Socks Day

We started Anti-Bullying Week with Odd Socks Day on Monday. Throughout the week, children have celebrated the things that make us all different and special.

We have been encouraging everyone to use their 'power for good' and to notice and celebrate positive actions.

Each class has been gathering stories of kindness, courage and children who have stood out for making good choices and supporting others.

Occupational Therapy Training for Staff

Over the last few weeks, all staff have been taking part in Occupational Therapy (OT) training to enhance our LEPS Universal Offer, ensuring we can continue to support children across the school effectively.

COMMUNITY SCHOOLS CONSULTATION

Ealing council is consulting on a proposed change to the admissions arrangements for community schools for entry in September 2027 with the introduction of a staff child criterion. Under the proposed criterion, priority would be given to children of staff who:

- *Have been employed at the school for a minimum of two years at the time of application*
- *Are employed in a post where there is a demonstrable skill shortage*

This criterion would be placed below looked after and previously looked after children and siblings, but above distance only based admissions.

Ealing Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme



We are delighted to be delivering in Ealing the **Winter 2025 Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme!**

The HAF programme provides funded holiday provision, including healthy food and enriching activities, for children and young people in school years from reception to year 11 who reside in or attend school in the London Borough of Ealing and are in receipt of benefits-related free school meals (FSM), or who are vulnerable and would benefit from a HAF place.

Please note that primary pupils receiving the universal free school meals offer are not eligible for the HAF programme

Winter 2025 HAF

Throughout Ealing, HAF providers will be offering a wide range of funded activities, as well as a healthy meal. Eligible children and young people can attend for a **maximum of 4 days** over the Christmas school holiday. Ealing's Winter HAF programme will run from **Monday 22 December 2025 - Friday 2 January 2026**.

Vulnerable Children and Young People: Applications Open Wednesday 29 October 2025

We are able to offer a limited number of HAF places to some vulnerable children and young people who would benefit from attending HAF provision but are not in receipt of benefits-related free school meals.

Professionals who are working with families who they feel would benefit will need to complete an [online referral application form](#) to apply for them to be able to access the Winter HAF programme. Please complete a separate form for each child you are referring.

Applications **open on Wednesday 29 October 2025 at 9am** and will **close on Thursday 1 January 2026 at 12 noon**. We advise that you complete the application as soon as possible to be able to secure the child or young person's eligibility and book a HAF provider placement. Please note that vulnerable places should not be used for childcare.

Promote to Eligible Families: Bookings Open Wednesday 12 November 2025

Eligible families (those in receipt of benefits-related free school meals) will receive an email with booking details over the coming weeks. If you are working with an eligible family, please encourage them to book their HAF place.

Nurturing Yourself While Nurturing Your Child

Self-care is essential for all parents. Not only to stay patient, but also to keep finding joy and delight that is present every day with your children- even on the difficult ones. Children are happier and will cooperate more when you are joyful, calm and present. When you are feeling stressed, they may believe it is their fault, feel anxious and that they are not good enough. Your big job then, is to make sure you are parenting yourself just as well as you are parenting your child.

How can parents help?

Try to tune into yourself as much as possible throughout the day. Take deep breaths whenever you can, breathing in calm and breathing out stress. When you are feeling irritable, it is important to stop and think about what it is you need right now to stay balanced: can you sit outside for 5mins or put on some music and dance? Have a glass of water? Plan something you can do for yourself later, once they are in bed. You can also find ways to nurture yourself through times in the day that tend to be most difficult. Perhaps you can drink a cup of tea during bedtime stories or start evening routine a little earlier. Finally, being present and slowing down will help you to take in the joy of every moment with your child and will replenish your spirit.

Sometimes we could all do with someone to talk to.
